

Policy on wellbeing of employees

Future Enterprises Limited (“FEL” / “Company”) recognizes the role of its all employees in generating, growing and sustaining the business. Accordingly, it is committed to creating and maintaining fair, safe, healthy, nurturing and vibrant work environment, across all its operations. We expect that our commitment to wellbeing of all employees is also followed by our Joint Ventures and Subsidiaries.

FEL respects the right to freedom of association, participation, and collective bargaining to all its employees. It provides and maintains equal opportunities at the time of recruitment as well as during the course of employment irrespective of caste, creed, gender, race, religion, disability or sexual orientation. In keeping with the applicable regulations, the Company does not use child labour, forced labour or any form of involuntary labour, paid or unpaid. The Company ensures timely payment of fair living wages to meet basic needs and economic security of the employees. The Company creates systems and practices to ensure a harassment free workplace where employees feel safe and secure in discharging their responsibilities.

FEL takes cognizance of the work-life balance of its employees, especially that of women and provides facilities for the wellbeing of its employees including those with special needs. FEL is committed to providing a workplace environment that is safe, hygienic, humane, and which upholds the dignity of the employees. To this end, Company appropriately communicates and trains the employees – permanent, temporary, contractual and casual, on a regular basis.

FEL ensures continuous skill and competence upgrading of all employees by providing access to necessary learning opportunities, on an equal and non-discriminatory basis. It promotes employee morale and career development through enlightened human resource interventions.

A senior manager of FEL champions the adherence to the policy. Provisions for listening and resolving stakeholder grievances and whistle blower mechanism are put in place vis a vis the provisions within the policy. In addition, FEL is subjected to periodic audit to assure the adherence to the provisions in this policy. Any major deviations and need for review of the policy is reported to the Board of Directors of the Company.
